Birth of Cain

Gen 4:1 KJV "And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD."

Gen 4:1 KJV "And Adam (1Cor 15:45) knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain (parallel explains character of Cain Isa 30:1 Matt 13:38 1John 3:12 2Thess 2:8), and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD."

1. Gen 3:15 KJV "And I (God) will put enmity between you (serpent-Lucifer Gen 3:1-7 Isa 1:4) and the woman (Eve-Israel), and between your (Lucifer) seed (2Thess 2:3,4,8 Rev 13:1-10 Acts 17:29) and her (Eve-Israel) seed; it (Seed of God Jesus Matt 1:18 John 1:1-3,14) shall bruise your (Lucifer) head, and you (Lucifer) shall bruise his (seed of God Jesus Matt 1:18) heel (Gen 49:17 John 19:30)."

Birth of Abel

Gen 4:2 KJV "And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground."

Gen 4:2 KJV "And she again bare his (Cain Acts 17:29) brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep (Shepherd Isa 40:11 {Good Shepherd John 10:11,14,26-27}), but Cain (husbandman see vineyard paper Mark 12:1-12) was a tiller of the ground (Gen 3:17,23)."

1. Act 17:28 For in him (Jesus) we (Christians) live (Eph 2:8-10 Rom 10:9,10), and move, and have our being (Acts 17:24); as certain also of your (denominationalists Rev 2&3) own (Rom 12:16 Titus 1:10-14 {poets Titus 1:12 2Cor 11:13-15 2Pet 2:1 1John 4:1 false prophets}) have said, **for we (denominationalists Isa 30:1,10 Matt 15:7-9 Isa 29:13 Ezek 33:31) are also his (God) offspring.

2. Act 17:29 Forasmuch then as we (Christians) are the offspring (John 3:3-8 1Pet 1:23 {Rev 22:16} [heirs]) of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead (Rom 1:20) is like unto gold, or silver, or stone (salt covenant Lev 2:13 Numbers 18:19 2Chron 13:5), graven by are and man's device (1Tim 3:7 snare of the devil Heb 5:12-6:1-6 paper). Gen 4:3 KJV "And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD."

Gen 4:3 KJV "And in process of time (when he got around to it Judges 11:4 2Chron 21:19 1Kings 17:7) it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground (unfit offering Num 18:12-13 {Gen 3:7 fig leaves Matt 21:19 fig tree}) an offering unto the LORD." Acts 17:29 parallel

□ 2Pe 2:20 KJV "For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning." 2Pe 2:21 KJV "For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known [it], to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them."

1. Hos 10:13 You have plowed wickedness, you have reaped iniquity; you have eaten the fruit of lies: because you did trust in your way, in the multitude of you mighty men.
2. Dan 8:23 And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance (man of sin), and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.

Abel Serves the Lord with Blood and Fat

Gen 4:4 KJV "And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:"

Gen 4:4 KJV "And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings (yearly born Num 18:19 {Eph 1:7 Col 1:14}) of his flock and of the fat thereof. **And the LORD had respect (Matt 23:35 righteous Abel) unto Abel and to his offering:**"

- ☐ Heb 9:22 without shedding of blood there is no remission of sin
 - ☐ Heb 11:4 By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaks. Heb 11:5 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. Heb 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
 - ☐ Heb 12:24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaks better things than *that of* Abel.
1. Rom 2:11 KJV "For there is no respect of persons with God."
 2. 1Pe 1:17 KJV "And if you call on the Father, who without respect of persons judges according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:"
 3. Isa 17:8 And he shall not look to the altars, the work of his hands, neither shall respect *that* which his fingers have made, either the groves, or the images.
 4. Pro 28:21 To have respect of persons *is* not good: **for for** (is a twain see twain paper) a piece of bread *that* man will transgress. Pro 28:22 He that hastes to be rich *has* an evil eye, and considers not that poverty shall come upon him. Pro 28:23 He that rebukes a man afterwards shall find more favor than he that flatters with the tongue.

Gen 4:5 KJV "But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell."

Gen 4:5 KJV "But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth (John 8:44 Lucifer murderer from the beginning Num 16:15), and his countenance fell."
(Cain parallels Lucifer, Judas is called a devil John 6:70)

- Jacob and Esau Gen 25:29 And Jacob sod pottage: and Esau came from the field, and he *was* faint: Gen 25:30 And Esau said to Jacob, feed me, I pray you, with that same red *pottage*; for I *am* faint: therefore was his name called Edom. Gen 25:31 And Jacob said, sell me this day your birthright. Gen 25:32 And Esau said, behold, I am at the point to die: and what profit shall this birthright do to me? Gen 25:33 And Jacob said, swear to me this day; and he swore unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob. Gen 25:34 Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentils; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised his birthright.

1. Isa 28:21 For the LORD shall rise up as *in* mount Perazim, he shall be wroth as *in* the valley of Gibeon, that he may do his work, his strange work; and bring to pass his act, his strange act.
2. Lam 5:22 But you have utterly rejected us; you are very wroth against us.
3. Jer 6:30 Reprobate silver shall *men* call them, because the LORD has rejected them.
4. Mat 18:33 *Should not you also have had compassion on your fellowservant, even as I had pity on you? Mat 18:34 And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him. Mat 18:35 So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if you from your hearts forgive not everyone his brother their trespasses.*
5. Luk 11:50 That *the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation; Luk 11:51 From the blood of Abel unto the blood of Zacharias, which perished between the altar and the temple: verily I say unto you, it shall be required of this generation. Luk 11:52 Woe unto you, lawyers! for you have taken away the key of knowledge: you entered not in yourselves, and they that were entering in you hindered.*
6. Rev 12:13 And when the dragon (Lucifer) saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman (Israel) which brought forth the man *child (Jesus)*. Rev 12:14 And to the woman (Israel) were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time (Last half of Tribulation), from the face of the serpent. Rev 12:15 And the serpent (Lucifer) cast out of his mouth (authority) water (army) as a flood after the woman (Israel), that he (Lucifer) might cause her (Israel) to be carried away of the flood (army). Rev 12:16 And the earth helped the woman (Israel), and the earth opened (earthquake) her mouth, and swallowed up the flood (army) which the dragon (Lucifer) cast out of his mouth (authority). Rev 12:17 And the dragon (Lucifer) was wroth with the woman (Israel), and went to make war with the remnant of her (Israel) seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Gen 4:6 KJV "And the LORD said unto Cain, why are you wroth? and why is your countenance fallen (Gen 4:5)?"

Gen 4:6 KJV "And the LORD said unto Cain, why are you wroth (Gen 4:5)? and why is your countenance fallen (Luke 10:18 Lucifer falls)?"

- Rev 12:17 And the dragon (Lucifer) was wroth with the woman (Israel), and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- Isa 1:9 Except the LORD of hosts had left unto us a very small remnant, we should have been as Sodom, *and* we should have been like unto Gomorrah. Isa 1:10 Hear the word of the LORD, you rulers of Sodom; give ear unto the law of our God, you people of Gomorrah.

Extreme Hatred

1. Hab 1:3 Why do you show me iniquity, and cause *me* to behold grievance? for spoiling and violence *are* before me: and there are *that* raise up strife and contention. Hab 1:4 Therefore the law is slacked, and judgment does never go forth: for the wicked do compass about the righteous; therefore wrong judgment proceeds.
2. Psa 12:1 **To the chief Musician upon Sheminith, A Psalm of David.** Help, LORD; for the godly man ceases; for the faithful fail from among the children of men. Psa 12:2 They speak vanity every one with his neighbor: *with* flattering lips *and* with a double heart do they speak.
3. Psa 41:9 Yes, my own familiar friend (John 13:18), in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, has lifted up *his* heel against me.
4. Mat 10:34 **Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.** Mat 10:35 **For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.** Mat 10:36 **And a man's foes *shall be* they of his own household.**
5. Mat 10:21 **And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against *their* parents, and cause them to be put to death.**
6. Luk 22:48 KJV "But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betray you the Son of man with a kiss?"

Gen 4:7 KJV "If you do well, shall you not be accepted? and if you do not well, sin lies at the door. And unto you shall be his desire, and you shall rule over him."

Gen 4:7 KJV "If you (Cain) do well, shall you (Cain) not be accepted (Acts 17:34,35)? and if you do not well (Gen 4:14,15), sin lies at the door (Heb 5:12-6:1-6). And unto you (Cain) shall be his (Abel) desire, and you (Cain) shall rule over him (Abel Gen 4:9 Rom 6:23)."

☐ If Cain, the older brother, does well he will rule over Abel.

Offer of Authority

1. Gen 25:23 And the LORD said unto her, two nations *are* in your womb, and two manner of people shall be separated from your bowels; and *the one* people shall be stronger than *the other* people; and the elder shall serve the younger.
2. Isa 3:9 The show of their countenance doth witness against them; and they declare their sin as Sodom, they hide *it* not. Woe unto their soul! for they have rewarded evil unto themselves.
3. Mat 23:13 But **woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for you neither go in yourselves, neither suffer you them that are entering to go in.**
4. Act 10:34 Then Peter opened *his* mouth, and said, of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: Act 10:35 But in every nation he that fears him, and works righteousness, is accepted with him.

Gen 4:8 KJV "And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him."

Gen 4:8 KJV "And Cain talked with Abel his brother (Gen 4:7): and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel (Gen 4:9-10) his brother, and slew him."

Communication between Cain and Abel

1. Mat 13:38-40 *The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one;* Mark 12:1-12 see Vineyard paper Parable of the vine growers
2. Mat 24:40 *Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.*
3. Psa 36:3 The words of his mouth *are* iniquity and deceit: he has left off to be wise, *and* to do good.
4. Pro 26:24-25 He that hates dissembles with his lips, and lays up deceit within him; Pro 26:25 When he speaks fair, believe him not: for *there are* seven abominations in his heart.
5. Mic 7:6 For the son dishonor the father, the daughter rises up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies *are* the men of his own house.
6. Psa 55:21 *The words* of his mouth were smoother than butter, but war *was* in his heart: his words were softer than oil, yet *were* they drawn swords.
7. Luk 22:48 But Jesus said unto him, *Judas, betray you the Son of man with a kiss?*

Cain Rises Up Against Abel

1. 2Sa 14:6 And your handmaid had two sons, and they two strove together in the field, and *there was* none to part them, but the one smote the other, and slew him.
2. Psa 139:19 Surely you shall slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, you bloody men. Psa 139:20 For they speak against you wickedly, *and* your enemies take *your name* in vain.
3. Psa 24:4 He that has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully. Psa 24:5 He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation. Psa 24:6 This *is* the generation of them that seek him, that seek your face, O Jacob. Selah.

Gen 4:9 KJV "And the LORD said unto Cain, where is Abel your brother? And he said, "I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?"

Gen 4:9 KJV "And the LORD said unto Cain (Gen 4:11), where is Abel your brother (Gen 4:8)? And he said, "I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?"

Back Talking God

1. Gen 3:9 And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where *are you*? Gen 3:10 And he said, I heard your voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I *was* naked; and I hid myself. Gen 3:11 And he said, who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded you that you should not eat?
2. Psa 9:12 When he makes inquisition for blood, he remembers them: he forgets not the cry of the humble.
3. Pro 28:13 He that covers his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesses and forsakes *them* shall have mercy.
4. Mat 27:3 Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, Mat 27:4 Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. Mat 27:7 And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.
5. Joh 8:44 You (Pharisees and scribes) are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Gen 4:10 KJV "And he said, what have you done? the voice of your brother's blood cries unto me from the ground."

Gen 4:10 KJV "And he said, what have you done (Gen 4:9)? the voice of your brother's blood (Gen 4:8,11) cries unto me from the ground."

People not taking Accountability

1. Gen 3:13 And the LORD God said unto the woman, what *is* this *that* you have done? And the woman said, the serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.
2. Gen 18:20 And the LORD said, because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous;
3. Exo 3:7 And the LORD said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which *are* in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; (parallels Rev 5:8 cry of the saints)
4. Psa 72:14 He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.
5. Isa 5:7 For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts *is* the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgment, but behold oppression; for righteousness, but behold a cry.
6. Heb 12:24 **And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaks better things than *that* of Abel.**
7. Jas 5:4 Behold, the hire of the laborers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, cries: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth.

Gen 4:11 KJV "And now are you cursed from the earth, which has opened her mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand;"

Gen 4:11 KJV "And now are you (Cain Gen 4:9-10) cursed from the earth, which has opened her (Gen 4:10) mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand (Gen 4:10);"

Cursed from the Earth (Isa 1:15 hands full of blood)

□ Job 31:39 If I have eaten the fruits thereof without money, or have caused the owners thereof to lose their life:

1. Gen 3:14 And the LORD God said unto the serpent, because you have done this, you are cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon your belly shall you go, and dust shall you eat all the days of your life:
2. Jer 17:5 **Thus says the LORD; cursed be the man that trusts in man, and makes flesh his arm, and whose heart departs from the LORD.**
3. Mal 4:5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: Mal 4:6 And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.
4. Mal 3:7 Even from the days of your fathers you are gone away from my ordinances, and have not kept *them*. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, says the LORD of hosts. But you said, wherein shall we return? Mal 3:8 Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed me. But you say, Wherein have we robbed you? In tithes and offerings. Mal 3:9 You *are* cursed with a curse: for you have robbed me (Read Matt 23 paper), *even* this whole nation.
5. Zec 5:3 Then said he unto me, this *is* the curse that goes forth over the face of the whole earth: for every one that steals shall be cut off *as* on this side according to it; and every one that swears shall be cut off *as* on that side according to it. Zec 5:4 **I will bring it forth, says the LORD of hosts, and it shall enter into the house of the thief, and into the house of him that swears falsely by my name: and it shall remain in the midst of his house, and shall consume it with the timber thereof and the stones thereof.**
6. Luk 21:35 **For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth.**
7. Isa 26:21 For, behold, the LORD comes out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain.

Gen 4:12 KJV "When you till the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto you her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shall you be in the earth."

Gen 4:12 KJV "When you till the ground, it shall not henceforth (Gen 4:15) yield unto you her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shall you be in the earth."

Punishment

- ☐ Jhn 8:44 KJV "You are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it."
- 1. Gen 3:17 And unto Adam he said, because you have hearkened unto the voice of your wife, and have eaten of the tree, of which I commanded you, saying, you shall not eat of it: cursed *is* the ground for your sake; in sorrow shall you eat *of* it all the days of your life; Gen 3:18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to you; and you shall eat the herb of the field; Gen 3:19 In the sweat of your face shall you eat bread, till you return unto the ground; for out of it were you taken: for dust you *are*, and unto dust shall you return.
- 2. Lev 26:20 And your strength shall be spent in vain: for your land shall not yield her increase, neither shall the trees of the land yield their fruits.
 - ☐ 1Co 15:2 By which also you are saved, if you keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless you have believed in vain.
- 3. Gal 2:19 For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God. Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. Gal 2:21 I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness *come* by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.
- 4. Rom 8:20 For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who has subjected *the same* in hope, Rom 8:21 Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. Rom 8:22 For we know that the whole creation groans and travails in pain together until now.
- 5. Psa 109:4 For my love they are my adversaries: but I *give myself unto* prayer. Psa 109:5 And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my love. Psa 109:6 Set you a wicked man over him: and let Satan stand at his right hand. Psa 109:7 When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin. Psa 109:8 Let his days be few; *and* let another take his office. Psa 109:9 Let his children be fatherless, and his wife a widow. Psa 109:10 Let his children be continually vagabonds, and beg: let them seek *their bread* also out of their desolate places. Hos 9:17 My God will cast them away, because they did not hearken unto him: and they shall be wanderers among the nations.
 - ☐ Act 1:16 Men *and* brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spoke before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus. Act 1:17 For he was numbered with us, and had obtained part of this ministry. Act 1:18 Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out. Act 1:19 And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, Aceldama, that is to say, The field of blood. Act 1:20 For it is written in the book of Psalms, Let his habitation be desolate, and let no man dwell therein: and his bishopric let another take.

Paralleling Punishment of Cain
