Brother of James

1. Mic 7:6 For the son dishonors the father, the daughter rises up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies *are* the men of his own house.
2. Luk 6:16 And Judas *the brother* of James, and Judas Iscariot, which also was the traitor.
3. Mat 10:34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. Mat 10:35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. Heb 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all*. Heb 10:11 And every priest stands daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down on the right hand of God; Heb 10:13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool. when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation,

1. Pro 4:23 Keep your heart with all diligence; for out of it *are* the issues of life.
2. Luk 12:58 *When you go with your adversary to the magistrate, as you art in the way, give diligence that you may be delivered from him; lest he hale you to the judge, and the judge deliver you to the officer, and the officer cast you into prison*
3. 2Co 8:7 Therefore, as you abound in *everything*, *in* faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and *in* all diligence, and *in* your love to us, see that you abound in this grace also.
4. 2Pe 1:5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;
5. 2Pe 1:10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if you do these things, you shall never fall:

1. Psa 1:1 Blessed *is* the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stand in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful.
 - Pro 29:8 Scornful men bring a city into a snare: but wise *men* turn away wrath.
 - Isa 28:14 Wherefore hear the word of the LORD, you scornful men, that rule this people which *is* in Jerusalem. Isa 28:15 Because you have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves:
 - Psa 18:4 The sorrows of death compassed me, and the floods of ungodly men made me afraid.
2. Pro 16:27 An ungodly man digs up evil: and in his lips *there is* as a burning fire.
3. Luk 22:48 But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrays you the Son of man with a kiss?
4. 2Pe 3:7 But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.
5. Jud 1:15 To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard *speeches* which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

1. Rom 11:5 Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace. Rom 11:6 And if by grace, then *is it* no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if *it be* of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work. Rom 11:7 What then? Israel has not obtained that which he seeks for; but the election has obtained it, and the rest were blinded
2. Eph 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ, (by grace you are saved;)
3. 1Co 6:15 Know you not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make *them* the members of an harlot? God forbid. 1Co 6:16 What? know you not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, says he, shall be one flesh.
4. Rev 17:4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet color, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication: Rev 17:5 And upon her forehead *was* a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

THE TRUE CHURCH

1. Mat 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, **You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.** Mat 16:17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, **Blessed are you, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood has not revealed *it* unto you, but my Father which is in heaven.** Mat 16:18 **And I say also unto you, That you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.**
2. Act 20:28 **Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost has made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he has purchased with his own blood.**
3. Heb 12:23 **To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven,** and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, Heb 12:24 **And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaks better things than *that of Abel.***

Fake Church

2. 5. Rev 1:20 **The mystery of the seven stars which you saw In my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which you saw are the seven churches.**
6. Rev 2:9 I know **your** works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but you art rich) and *I know* the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, **but are the synagogue of Satan.**
7. Rev 2:13 I know your works, and where you dwellest, **even where Satan's seat is:** and you hold fast my name, and has not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, **where Satan dwelleth.**
8. Rev 2:24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and **which have not known the depths of Satan,** as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.
9. Rev 3:9 Behold, I will make **them of the synagogue of Satan,** which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you.

Jude 1:5a I will therefore put you in remembrance,

1. Rev 2:5 Remember therefore from whence you art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto you quickly, and will remove your candlestick out of his place, except you repent.
2. Rev 3:3 Remember therefore how you has received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore you shall not watch, I will come on you as a thief, and you shall not know what hour I will come upon you.
3. 3Jn 1:10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he does, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbids them that would, and casts *them* out of the church.
4. Rev 2:6 But this you has, that you hates the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.
5. Rev 2:22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds
6. Rev 16:11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

Jud 1:18 How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. 3. Gal 5:21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, raveling's, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told *you* in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God
4. Joh 8:40 But now you seek to kill me, a man that has told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.
5. Hab 1:5 Behold you among the heathen, and regard, and wonder marvelously: for *I* will work a work in your days, *which* you will not believe, though it be told *you*.

1. Exo 11:7 But against any of the children of Israel shall not a dog move his tongue, against man or beast: that you may know how that the LORD doth put a difference between the Egyptians and Israel.
2. Exo 18:8 And Moses told his father in law all that the LORD had done unto Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel's sake, *and* all the travail that had come upon them by the way, and *how* the LORD delivered them.
3. Exo 9:7 And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.
4. Jos 9:24 And they answered Joshua, and said, Because it was certainly told your servants, how that the LORD your God commanded his servant Moses to give you all the land, and to destroy all the inhabitants of the land from before you, therefore we were sore afraid of our lives because of you, and have done this thing.
5. 1Co 10:9 Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents.

Followers of Lucifer

Jud 1:6 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

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Followers of Evil

1. Joh 8:44 You are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
2. Gen 6:4 There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare *children* to them, the same *became* mighty men which were of old, men of renown.
3. Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
4. Mat 25:41 *Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, you cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:*
5. 2Pe 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;
6. Mat 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with you, Jesus, you Son of God? art you come hither to torment us before the time?
7. Rev 2:5 *Remember therefore from whence you art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto you quickly, and will remove your candlestick out of his place, except you repent.*
8. Rev 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Sodom and Gomorrha

Jud 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

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Fornication and Strange Flesh

1. Gen 13:13 But the men of Sodom *were* wicked and sinners before the LORD exceedingly. Gen 18:20 And the LORD said, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous;
2. Gen 19:24 Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven; Gen 19:25 And he overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all the inhabitants of the cities, and that which grew upon the ground. Gen 19:26 But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.
3. Eze 16:49 Behold, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. Eze 16:50 And they were haughty, and committed abomination before me: therefore I took them away as I saw *good*.
4. Luk 17:29 **But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed *them* all.**
5. Gen 19:5 And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where *are* the men which came in to you this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them.
6. Rom 1:26 For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: Rom 1:27 And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.
7. Mat 25:41 **Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, you cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:**

Reprobate Min

Jud 1:8 Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

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Those Walking after the Flesh

1. 1Co 3:17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which *temple* you are.
2. 1Ti 1:10 For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with humanity, for men-stealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine; 2Pe 2:10 But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous *are they*, self-willed, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. 2Pe 2:11 Whereas angels, which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them before the Lord. 2Pe 2:12 But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption; afraid of sound doctrine;
3. Gen 3:5 For God doth know that in the day you eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and you shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.
4. Rev 2:20 *Notwithstanding I have a few things against you, because you suffer woman Jezebel, which callsherself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols. Rev 2:21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.*
5. Rev 2:14 *But I have a few things against you, because you has there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.*
6. Rev 18:3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

Michael the Archangel

Jud 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, does not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke you.

Mat 4:4 But he answered and said, *it is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.* Mat 4:5 Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and sets him on a pinnacle of the temple, Mat 4:6 And says unto him, If you be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning you: and in *their* hands they shall bear you up, lest at any time you dash your foot against a stone. Mat 4:7 Jesus said unto him, *it is written again, you shall not tempt the Lord your God.* Mat 4:8 Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and shows him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; Mat 4:9 And says unto him, all these things will I give you if you wilt fall down and worship me. Mat 4:10 Then says Jesus unto him, *get you hence, Satan: for it is written, you shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.* Mat 4:11 Then the devil leaves him, and behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

 2. Job 15:15 Behold, he puts no trust in his saints; yea, the heavens are not clean in his sight. Job 15:16 How much more abominable and filthy *is* man, which drinks iniquity like water?
 3. Job 4:18 Behold, he put no trust in his servants; and his angels he charged with folly:
 4. 2Pe 2:12 But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption; 2Pe 2:13 And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. Spots *they are* and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own deceiving while they feast with you; 2Pe 2:14 Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children: 2Pe 2:15 Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam *the son* of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; Continued on next page:

Isa 6:5 Then said I, Woe *is* me! for I am undone; because I *am* a man of unclean lips, and I

dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.

Those Wronging their own Soul

1. Psa 118:8 *It is* better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man.
2. Psa 40:4 Blessed *is* that man that makes the LORD his trust, and respects not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.
3. Jer 17:5 Thus says the LORD; Cursed *be* the man that trusts in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departs from the LORD. Jer 17:6 For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, *in* a salt land and not inhabited. Jer 17:7 Blessed *is* the man that trusts in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.
4. Jud 1:10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves. Jud 1:11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.
5. Rev 2:14 **But I (John) have a few things against you (moral denominationalists) because you have their them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught (1) Balac to cast a stumbling block before the children of Israel, (2) to eat things sacrificed unto idols, (3) and to commit fornication. Rev 2:15 So have you (moral denominationalists) also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.**

- Jer 11:8 Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, **but walked everyone in the imagination of their evil heart**: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded *them* to do; but they did *them* not.
1. Isa 5:20 **Woe unto them** that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! Isa 5:21 **Woe unto them** *that are* wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight! Isa 5:22 **Woe unto them** *that are* mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink:
 2. Mar 7:20 And he said **that which come out of the man, that defiles the man**. Mar 7:21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, Mar 7:22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: Mar 7:23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.

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Evil Good and Good Evil

- o Num 31:16 Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through

the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the LORD in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD.

1. Job 21:14 **Therefore they say unto God, Depart from us; for we desire not the knowledge of your ways. Job 21:15 What is the Almighty, that we should serve him? and what profit should we have, if we pray unto him?**
2. Hos 1:2 The beginning of the word of the LORD by Hosea. And the LORD said to Hosea, **Go, take unto you a wife of whoredoms and children of whoredoms: for the land has committed great whoredom, departing from the LORD.**
3. Job 25:5 Behold even to the moon, and it shines not; yea, the stars (angels) are not pure in his sight.
4. Job 21:14 **Therefore they say unto God, Depart from us; for we desire not the knowledge of your ways. Job 21:15 What is the Almighty, that we should serve him? and what profit should we have, if we pray unto him?**
5. Rom 3:2 Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of God. Rom 3:3 For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect? Rom 3:4 God forbid: **yea, let God be true, but every man a liar**; as it is written, That you might be justified in your sayings, and might overcome when you are judged.
6. Mat 15:14 Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.
7. Ecc 10:8 He that digs a pit shall fall into it; and whoso breaks an hedge, a serpent shall bite him.
8. 1Ti 6:10 **For the love of money is the root of all evil:** which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
9. 2Ti 4:10 For Demas has forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia. 2Ti 4:11 **Only Luke is with me. Take Mark, and bring him with you: for he is profitable to me for the ministry.**

1. Isa 45:3 And **I will give you the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places**, that you mayest know that I, the LORD, which call *you* by your name, *am* the God of Israel. Isa 45:4 For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, **I have even called you by your name: I have surnamed (last name) you**, though you have not known me. Isa 45:5 *I am* the LORD, and *there is* none else, *there is* no God beside me: I girded you, though you have not known me: Isa 45:6 That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that *there is* none beside me. *I am* the LORD, and *there is* none else. Isa 45:7 I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these *things*. Isa 45:8 Drop down, you heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness: let the earth open, and let them bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together; I the LORD have created it. Isa 45:9 Woe unto him that strives with his **Maker**! Let the potsherd *strive* with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashions it, What do you make? or your work, He has no hands? Isa 45:10 Woe unto him that says unto *his* father, What beget you? or to the woman, What have you brought forth? Isa 45:11 Thus says the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command you me. Isa 45:12 **I have made the earth, and created man upon it**: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded.
2. Psa 11:3 If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do? Psa 11:4 **The LORD is in his holy temple, the LORD'S throne is in heaven (Rev 14:14): his eyes behold**, his eyelids try, the children of men. Psa 11:5 The LORD tries the righteous: but the wicked and him that loves violence his soul hates. Psa 11:6 Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: *this shall be* the portion of their cup. Psa 11:7 For the righteous LORD loves righteousness; his countenance does behold the upright.
3. Isa 17:7 At that day shall a man look to his Maker, and his eyes shall have respect to the Holy One of Israel. Isa 17:8 And he shall not look to the altars, the work of his hands, neither shall respect *that* which his fingers have made, either the groves, or the images. 2. Heb 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, Heb 6:2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. Heb 6:3 And this will we do, if God permit. Heb 6:4 For *it is impossible* for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, Heb 6:5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, Heb 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put *him* to an open shame.
3. 2Pe 2:17 These are wells without water, clouds that are carried with a tempest; to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever. 2Pe 2:18 For when they speak great swelling *words* of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, *through much* wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. 2Pe 2:19 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage. 2Pe 2:20 For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. 2Pe 2:21 For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known *it*, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. 2Pe 2:22 But it happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog *is* turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.
